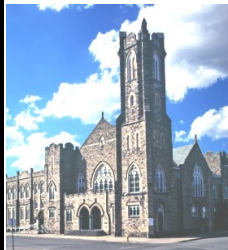

Presbyterian World Service & Development responds to situations where indigenous people are marginalized and denied their rights. Like many other indigenous Maya- Mam women in Guatemala, Aurelia Jimenez has suffered discrimination and poverty. "Our lives are hard," she shares, but she is committed to making a difference for her family. Through a PWS&D-supported program, she and other Maya-Mam women are learning how to improve the way they plant crops and prepare the new food they are growing. The program also promotes gender equality and women's rights. Because of this, Aurelia found the courage to advocate for herself within the broader community—inspiring others with a vision for a brighter tomorrow.
