From Rev. Joyce,

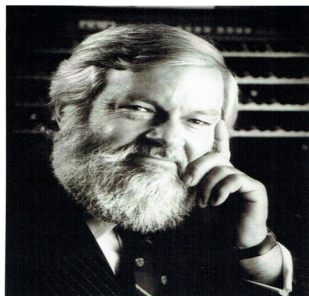
