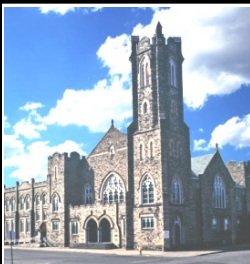

Rev. Joyce is in need of a dozen or so shoeboxes for use in the service on January 22. If you have some, please drop them by the office.

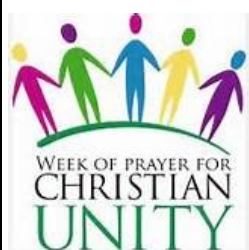


BAPTISM
