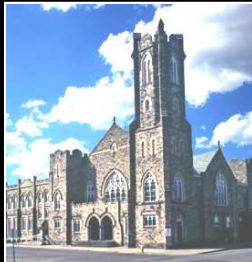

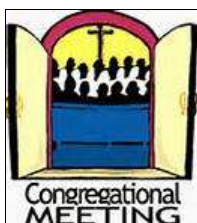

February 12th is also the date for a tasty coffee hour/luncheon hosted by the Evening Guild.

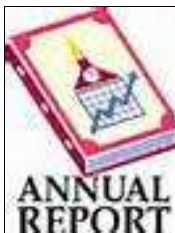

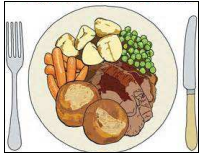
PWS&D Sunday

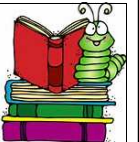

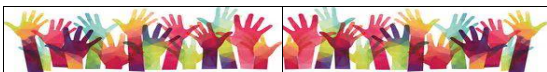
