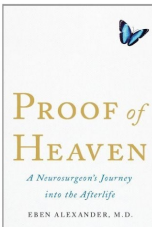

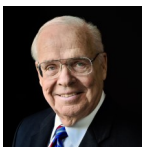
There will even be live entertainment by Brother John and Friends! The cost is \$5 for Adults and a Family of 4 or more \$15. Children under 3 are free.

From Rev. Joyce,

No surprise to you, each week I have to write a sermon, one that I hope speaks to the lives of those who attend worship or read the sermons online. Throughout the week I study the scriptures, read commentaries, listen to podcasts, search out resources and pray about the sermon as well as the entire service. I really enjoy this part of my ministry and give thanks that the Presbyterian Church feels ordained ministry is important. Through your support, both financial and prayerful, I am freed to do this work in response to God's call on my life and your call for me to minister here.



As I have been pondering how to minister in a way that speaks into the lives of others, I am coming to understand more and more that I need to know your stories. Visiting with people is very helpful and to that end I am always grateful for the time that is set aside for visits. But I would like to put a request out there that may seem a little crazy, but if you are interested I am really excited to do. Would you be willing to have me hang out for you for a day? I don't care if you are retired, still working, a stay at home parent, whatever. I don't care if it is spent at appointments, reading quietly at home, changing diapers, in a garage, going out for coffee, in a meeting, in the garden, or whatever else a day may bring. I am interested in what you face each day - your story. I hope that even if the idea sounds a little out there, you will respond, and don't worry, you will not end up the focus of a sermon, but just maybe I can speak into the lives of our people through my experience with you.
