

ORGAN UPDATE

First of all, thank you! Thank you to those who were able to give above and beyond their regular offerings to help raise the funds to do the extensive maintenance that was needed to keep St. Andrew's historic organ in excellent condition. It was a wonderful day when Connor let the organ open up on the last hymn so that we could hear the magnificent sound. We had fundraised just over \$20,000 for the work as per the quote given by Dodington & Dodington of Toronto. This company has done the regular maintenance on this organ and others in the city for a long number of years. The plan was to have the work done this past summer. That work was delayed until September, which meant that other organs in the city would be tuned a little ahead of the normal October schedule. This worked to our advantage as the cost of travel was split between all the congregations who used Dodington's services. Our bill came to a \$15,181.55. We saved a full \$4,000.00 off the original quote. Though there may be challenges St. Andrew's faces in the coming months and year in regards to our building that change this position, Session's hope is to leave this money set aside for future tuning and maintenance of the organ. Once again, thank you for your generosity.

violence were taking place in their own neighbourhood. The family escaped to Kfarbo and forged a home in a cramped, unfurnished apartment.

Navigating the streets of a brand -new city, in a country broken by

over eight years of civil conflict, Ahmad and Sarah prayed each day for peace and relief from hunger.

Last week we began our countdown to Christmas morning by adding ornaments to the Jesse Tree. As I wrote last week, the Jesse Tree began in Medieval times as a pictorial way to teach about Jesus' lineage

starting from creation. It is called the Jesse Tree based on Isaiah 11:1, "A shoot shall come out from the stock of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots." (NRSV) I was asked to list the ornaments and their meaning so that it would be easier to follow as the weeks pass. So here it goes in order of the ornament, what it symbolizes and the scripture reference.

Earth – Creation Gen 1:1-31. 2:1-4

Apple and Serpent – Adam and Eve Gen 2:7-9, 18-24; 3:1-7

Rainbow – Noah Gen 6;5-8, 13-22; 7:17,23,24; 8:1,6-22

> Star – Abraham Gen 12:1-3; 15:1-11

> Ram's Horn – Isaac Gen 22:1-14

Ladder – Jacob Gen 25:1-34; 28:10-15

Coat – Joseph Gen 37: 1-4, 23-28; 45:3-15

Stone Tablets – Moses Exodus 2:1-10; 20:1-21; 34:1-9

Lamp – Samuel 1 Samuel 3:1-18

Shepherds Staff (crozier) - Jesse 1 Samuel 16:1-13
