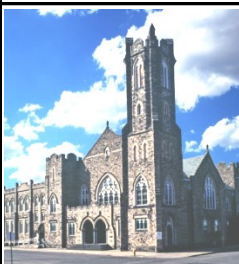
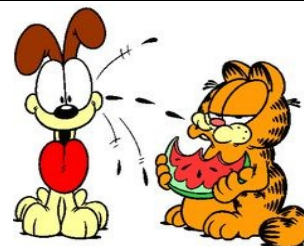

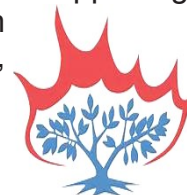


PRESBYTERIAN SHARING
