Joyce, In an effort to tackle a few things that are important to our congregation, I have been given approval by Session to start a music program called Music Pups. It is a music appreciation program for children 0 - 4 years of age that will run for 45 minutes, one day a week for 10 weeks, at a cost of \$125.00 for the first child, \$90.00 for the second, and no cost for a 3 child. All the children must be from the same family. It will begin the last week of March with two options for classes, Wednesday from 4:30 – 5:15 and Thursdays 11:00 – 11:45. The hope and intent is that the program will be helpful in a number of ways. This will be an opportunity to engage young families in the life and work of the church, to have people get used to the area and the building and find that it is a good place to be. In the long run, the plan is to also find sponsors so the program can become an outreach for lower income families that would not otherwise be able to introduce their children to music in this way. Money from the program will go into the operating budget of the church, which is also a great need for us at this time. One more personal reason for the programI will get many more hugs
