

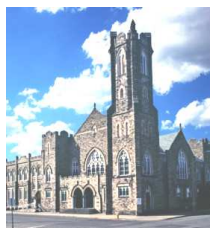

Recognized in 2006 it is a historical instrument worthy of citation, now in need of maintenance to make sure it continues for another 100
