





World Communion Sunday, an opportunity to show the unity of Christians around the globe. Sometimes it seems like churches have more differences than commonalities when it comes to faith. But one thing that can be agreed upon is that Communion, The Lord's Supper, Eucharist, however you name it, is central to our practice as Christians. Today, churches of many denominations the world over are celebrating communion to demonstrate unity in Christ and foster ecumenical cooperation. Amidst conflicting world views, suffering, colonization, war-torn regions, this one thing we can do.

Here is the second last installment of the study on the fruit of the Spirit.

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience,
kindness, generosity, faithfulness,
gentleness and self-control.

Galatians 5:22-23.

“Gentleness: demonstrating consideration and thoughtfulness-putting my rights and strength willingly under God's control in order to handle myself in a calm manner. Gentleness requires openness, humility, and a teachable spirit, rather than the harshness originating from personal pride and selfishness. Gentleness is revealed through cooperation, humility, and accountability. A gentle person is not a weak person; rather, this person has put their strength under the control of God. Like a tamed horse, that strength is now useful and focused. A gentle person may act with feeling or tough decisiveness, yet they are under control. In Matthew 5:5 Jesus blesses the gently (meek).”

World Teachers' Day (Oct. 5)

Many children around the world do not have the opportunity to go to school for a variety of reasons—one of them is a lack of trained teachers. To improve access to quality education that helps children escape cycles of poverty, PWS&D's girls education project in Afghanistan runs workshops to strengthen the capacity of teachers. Teachers are educated about child rights, gender and peace, and trained in improved teaching methods to ensure that access to education translates to positive learning outcomes for girls and boys. “My lessons were difficult and sometimes boring for the students,” admits Ismatullah, a school teacher in Bamyan, Afghanistan. “After receiving this training, I learned interactive teaching methods that improve the teaching quality and engagement of the students during classroom activities.”
