The main entrance features two arches supported by ten polished granite columns with carved floral capitals. The carvings on the capitals and arches depict not only the Scottish thistle, which might be expected on a Presbyterian church, but also the English rose, the Welsh leek, the shamrock of Ireland, the lily of France, and the maple leaf of Canada, indicating that all are welcome.
