SHORTBREAD BAKERS

Many bakers make light work. For 200 lbs of butter, 10 baker means 20 lbs of butter each. If we can get 20 bakers, that's only 10 lbs each. Some will make more and some less. All baked shortbread should be packed in plastic bags in boxes or in cookie tins or airtight containers of some sort. If you want your container back, please label it. It will be kept frozen until it is packed by a separate group. All shortbread can be dropped off at the church during office hours or by arrangement.

Investing in the Future of the Church

Presbyterians Sharing supports the Near East School of Theology (NEST) in Beirut, Lebanon. For over a century, NEST has been a powerful witness in the Middle East, training nearly 90% of the Protestant ministers in the region. Students come from some of the most difficult places in the world to be Christian: Iran, Iraq, Syria, Lebanon and Palestine. NEST's President, Dr. George Sabra, shared, "The main concern of the church in the Middle East is how to remain here... We are preparing people to minister in situations where it is becoming very difficult for Christians to live." the time. It comes out one way or another. So, I have chosen to make time and take a week off to grieve and rest. It has been a tough few months for all of us. I have written about grief and loss a few times since Covid became our reality and affected everything from job security, to wedding plans and graduations, as well as significant other mile stones moments for so many. For me the last few weeks have been filled with the feelings of loss and grief. I have grieved not seeing my sons. It is nearly two years since I was physically present with my boys and daughters in law, over a year since I have been with my dad, and longer than that since I have been with siblings and their families. This summer was to be an Alberta summer where I would have time to be with all of them. Those plans had to be scrapped. Then just over two weeks ago two of my friends died within three days of each other, both far too young,

still working, and with many plans for the future.

Finally, out of the last ten weeks I have done nine funerals, which means that I also met with families every week to plan and share. I had connections with all of the families and grieve with them. Most had connections to this church in one way or another. Which brings me to another loss. Those who attend worship know how much hugging is a part of how I share joy, sorrow, comfort, and a greeting. It has been difficult enough to not be able to do that for the last few months, but when that can no longer be a part of my ministry to those who are grieving, then that impacts me. I share this because I want you to know I understand and have empathy for what you may be going through if you are grieving. I also want to let you know it is okay to grieve and to take time to sit with that. Which is why I will be taking the week off. I know it takes more than a week to grieve, but it is still important to take the time away from the regular and get some respite. For me the process includes reading and journaling and being outside, even if it is just to sit on a park bench. I also want you to know that I am okay. I still have much joy and continue to find fulfillment in my work among you. It is just time for a rest. May this coming week be one of rest and blessing for all of us.
