If you thought I was done sharing good news, well I am not We had a number of Christmas initiatives going and I would like to share a little. With sales from Shepherds Pies, St. Andrew's was able to support Shelter House and Lifewater Canada. In hopes of brightening the day of people in challenging and transitioning times of the lives. Presents for Peace, which is donations of gifts, St. Andrew's was able to support Women's Shelters in the city as well as the Elizabeth Fry Society of Northwestern Ontario. Throughout the year we support the Thunder Bay Food Bank on Miles Street with food drives. Our most recent food drive that ended in November netted over 450lbs of food. Workers at the food bank shared that this amount of food is considered a large donation. We also collected socks and underwear for the Undercover Project of Community Clothing Assistance. This program aims to provide socks and underwear for children ages 4-14 for a year. We brought them eight groceries bags full of items. A large bag of mittens, knitted by individuals of the church and sold at the Bazaar, was purchased by a donor and given to a teacher at St. James Public to be given to students in need. This bag of mittens is given in the name of St. Andrew's Presbyterian. Each year this congregation budgets for and supports the Underground Gym, Our Kids Count, Christmas Cheer, and the Children's Aid Society as well.

We don't tend to be a congregation that publicly announces how we are supporting those in need in our community, but I want you to know that you are part of good work, generous giving, and hope-filled blessing. Thank you for prayers, financial support, and the gift of time that allows St. Andrew's to support the work of other organizations in our community.
