PCC MISSION MOMENTS

One of the pressing problems in Malawi is the lack of health-care workers. With only 600 doctors to look after a population of 19 million, Presbyterians Sharing is doing what it can to help fill this sizable gap by supporting Moses Silungwe as he pursues a Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery at Levy Mwanawasa Medical University in Zambia, which is a six-year program. His dream of becoming a general surgeon began when he was working as a senior clinician at the David Gordon Memorial Hospital, where he was later appointed acting head of the hospital's clinical department. Moses is grateful and excited to pursue his dream of becoming a doctor and serving the people of Malawi.

Blessings on this Christian Family Sunday, a day that many celebrate as Mother's Day, but my focus is actually taking me to the month of June. The last time the Implementation Team met part of our time was spent discussing worship. This is where the idea was presented to have a worship team to help plan Sunday worship throughout the year. You can look at last week's newsletter to see more of that discussion. As that Worship Team is still in the making, the Implementation Team took a look at what is coming up in the calendar with the recognition that June is Pride month and also has National Indigenous People's Sunday. From there the idea was submitted that we celebrate a Pride Sunday and also participate in the Pride March. These ideas were taken to Session and with their approval we designated June 4th as our Pride Sunday. This is particularly significant as the Presbyterian Church in Canada (PCC) only last year agreed that people of any sexual orientation can be married and/or ordained in the PCC. The Session of St. Andrew's has for years been an affirming Session and this has been known in our church so to have an opportunity to show our support of the 2SLGBTQI+ community and members of our congregation is something I am thankful for.

The way we plan to participate in Pride month is to hang a Pride Flag at the church the morning of June 2nd, the same day the Pride Flag goes up at City Hall. Then June 4th will be Pride Sunday with an opportunity to reflect on God's love for everyone. Finally, the morning of June 17th you are invited to join with me and others as we walk in the Pride March from Waverly Park to Red River Road. We are calling ourselves Presbyterian Pride and you are welcome to join our group as an ally of 2SLGBTQI+people or as one yourself who wants to know that there are people in the Presbyterian Church who stand with you. I will be extending an invitation to the congregations of First Presbyterian and Lakeview Presbyterian should they wish to join us.
