MISSION MOMENT

Chandha Kumari is a 16-year-old girl living in a rural village in India. She's the eldest of five siblings and the financial strain weighs heavily on her family. Amid these daily struggles is the threat of child marriage, which remains a common practice in her village. Financial and social pressures led Chandha's parents to consider marrying her off despite her age. This all changed when her mother attended a community awareness session on child marriage hosted by Presbyterian World Service & Development's local partner. Chandha's mother shared with her husband what she learned during the session. Armed with knowledge about the legal age for marriage and the detrimental effects of child marriage, they decided to prioritize Chandha's education and seek other financial resources to prevent her early marriage.

Shaundra, who has been with us in the office since October 2018 has taken on full time employment with a Chiropractor's office here in Thunder Bay. I miss seeing her regularly, but this time of transition was necessary for her as things change in her own life and I see that it was maybe a necessary change for our congregation as we move further into our New Beginnings work. The role and even the title of the job in the office is changing.

So we give thanks and praise for the gift Shaundra has been to us, while now looking forward to building new relationships with Jordan. Many of you will know Jordan as St. Andrew's is his church family. He was hired for his skills, knowledge, and experience, and know there will be much to learn, but he knows St. Andrew's and that is all bonus.

May God go with Shaundra and her family. May God also bless Jordan as he takes on this new role. I grieve, give thanks, and rejoice all at the same time. Transitions are like that, yet those moments can bring new opportunities, insights, and experiences for all. May God add a blessing to all of this, and to our work, ministry, and worship.
