You may recall that last week I was counting the Sundays to Christmas. Many people are making their holiday plans. Families are organizing who is going to be where and when. The stores, hardly waiting for Halloween and Remembrance Day to be over, have been working overtime to get Christmas displays and stock out. Businesses organizations are planning for Christmas parties and the Santa Claus parade just took place vesterday. Here at St. Andrew's much the same is happening. We are just wrapping up the shortbread sales which happen on purpose around this time of year. All that is left is more baking and the pickup dates. Then we have the St. Andrew's Community Christmas Concert on December 7th and our choir is working on the music that we will be singing for that event. Along with all of that activity is of course our regular Sunday worship with the first Sunday of Advent being November 30th.

This year, as we celebrate Advent, we are going to be using resources from Illustrated Ministry and their "The Will to Dream" Advent through Epiphany theme. Illustrated Ministry is the same group that creates the back pack tags in the fall and Nativity stickers at Christmas that we have been using for several years. They have been writing curriculum for all of that time as well and this year I found their theme and resources to have meaning for where our congregation and the world are at right now. Much of the thought going into this resource for Illustrated Ministry came out of reading the book The Prophetic Imagination by Walter Brueggemann. I will be reading the book and if anyone wants to read it with me let me know I would be happy to have a time of conversation around the book and how that connects with our Advent worship. I am looking forward to this time of worship as we learn together, sing, pray, rejoice, and as we are joined by guest musicians. December 14th is the next Children's Sunday, gathering also to enjoy a potluck lunch together. So much to look forward to! As you plan your Christmas schedule, remember to include Sunday worship. I promise it will deepen your experience of Christmas.
