## From Joyce

 One of the joyful things that happens for me every couple of months is heading off to Sister Leila Greco Apartments and Glacier Ridge Retirement Residence for communion services. I have been going to Sister Leila Greco for a couple of years, but only started going to Glacier Ridge in the last year. These two places did not happen by chance. Both homes have had Presbyterians connected with St. Andrew's Church who were eager to have a Presbyterian service and, at their request, I have been able to arrange for this. As it turns out, Presbyterians are outnumbered by others who are also grateful to have a Protestant service available to them, even if it only happens every second month.

For my part, there is such joy in doing this ministry. These two gatherings are becoming like their own little congregations where we welcome anywhere from nine to fifteen people at each service. There are people among them who support our ministry at St. Andrew's by sliding an offering into my hands. It is their response of gratitude to God for being able to worship as most of them are not easily able to attend a worship service in their home congregations. Each time I look forward to seeing those who are members of the St. Andrew's family, those who are becoming family, and the people who are checking out services for the first time. I am usually able to make time to stick around after services and in so doing have had meaningful conversations with various people. I get to hear their life stories and many of them want to talk about questions of faith. I give thanks that I can represent St. Andrew's and that our ministry is able to be in the community with others who desire to worship God.
